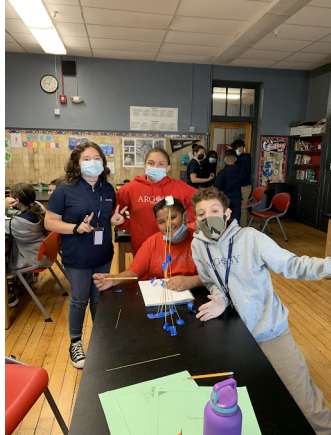

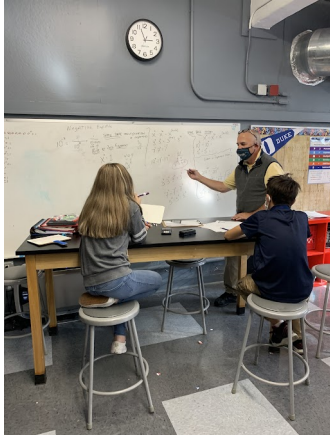

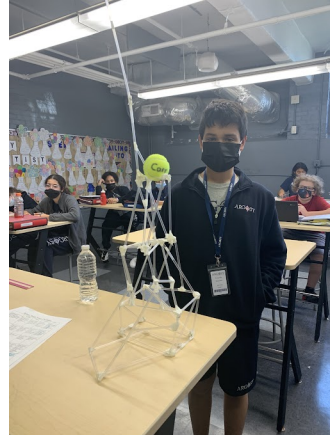

Seen here is the tallest straw tower created in grade 8 STEM and it's architect, Leonardo.



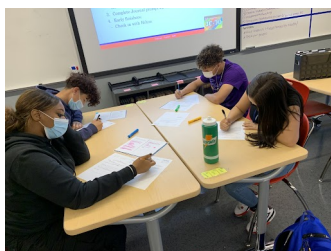

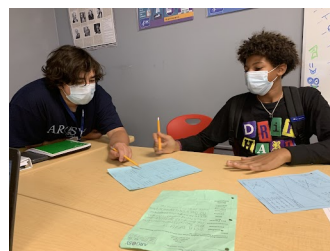

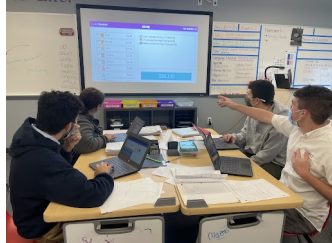

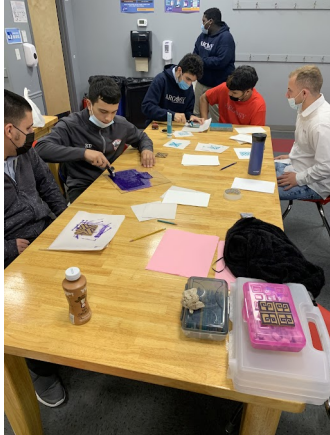

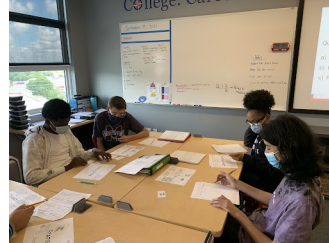
Our 9th grade scholars explaining concepts to each other during Soccer study hall.




