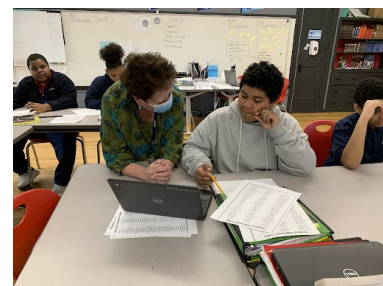

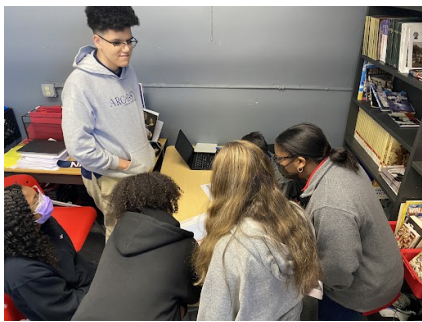

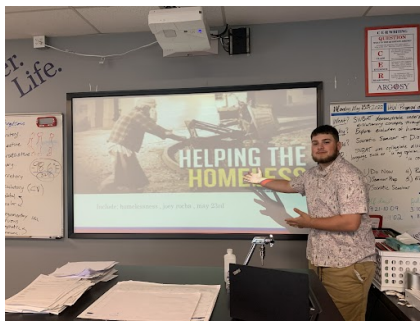

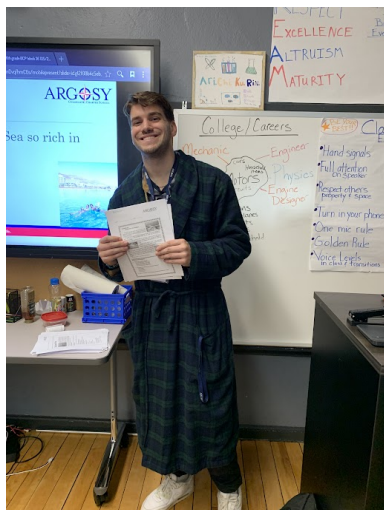

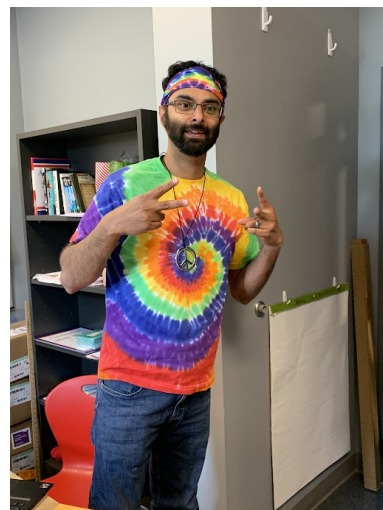

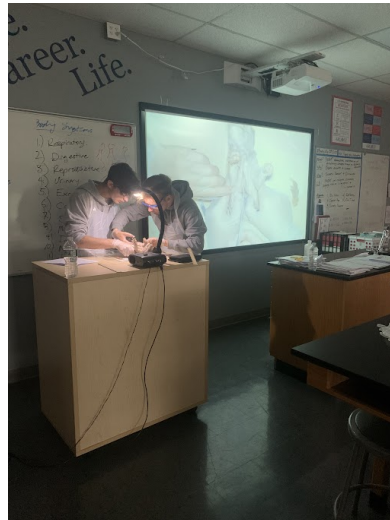

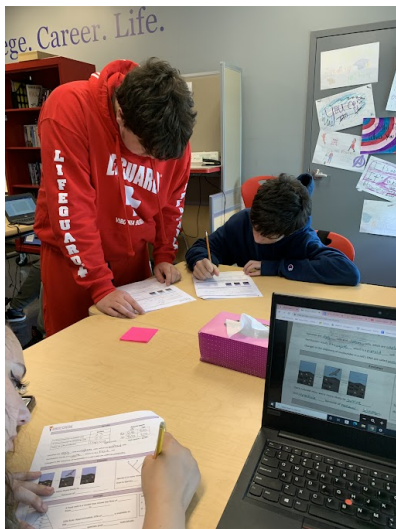

#### **Pandemic EBT Program Additional Food Support During COVID-19**
