Tutoring and Support Opportunities

Scholars are encouraged to stay after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays for support with current assignments, homework, and missing work. **This is especially important because there will be limited eligibility for summer programming this year.** Scholars should use the assistance provided during the school year to earn course credit, achieve a strong GPA, and stay on track for high school graduation and grade level matriculation.

In your scholar's report card packet from our recent Parent-Teacher Conferences, you may have received a letter indicating that a retention conversation was a possibility for your scholar. Please be on the lookout for further communication and utilize after-school tutoring to support your scholar's progress. Continued consultation with your scholar's advisor is also highly encouraged.

As a reminder, time is embedded in the school day for scholars to make sure they are completing assignments: at the High School, scholars have Study Hall blocks throughout the week, and at the Middle School, scholars have an Advisory block each Wednesday. It's important that scholars are making the most of this time.












